Finished Project Size: 8"x8"



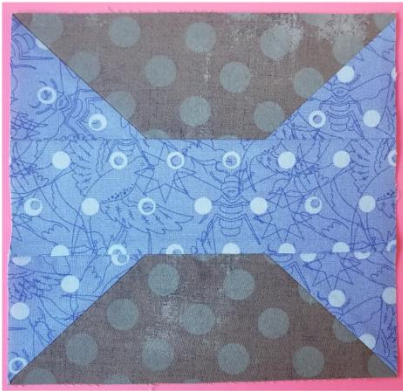

The Bow Ties for Loss #bowtiesforloss project was started as a way to help support families that have tragically lost children. I want to surround them with love from around the world to help support them during their time of grief and healing. I want them to have both comfort and hope for the future from a whole community of people pulling together for them.

Items that can be donated are quilt blocks, backing fabric, thread and batting. The address for See Cassie Make is included at the end of the pattern. Once received, I then assemble the pieces into beautiful quilts to donate to the families.

The following pattern is free and meant to be shared with others. I will be creating a website soon for you to check what background color I'm currently collecting, and unless specified the bow ties will be any and all colors. Thank you for helping with this loss project. It is always tragic when a child is lost too soon. Giving the family a bit of comfort by giving them a quilt is the goal.

Your finished Bow Tie block sizes will measure 8" x 8".

Please use a low volume light color for your background.

Please make your bow ties any color.

Cutting Directions

1 block

- A - cut 2 - 8" x 3" background rectangles
- B - cut 4 - 3" x 3" squares in a color
- C - cut 1 - 8" x 3" rectangle in the same color as your squares

3 blocks

- A - cut 6 - 8" x 3" background rectangles
- B - cut 12 - 3" x 3" squares in a color
- C - cut 3 - 8" x 3" rectangle in the same color as your squares

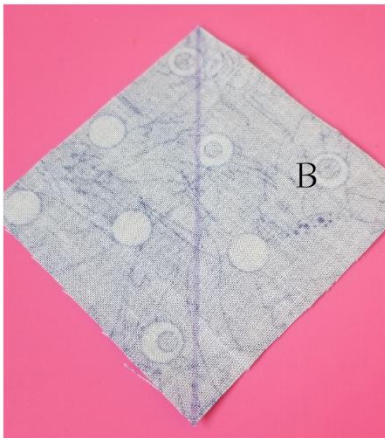
2 blocks

- A - cut 4 - 8" x 3" background rectangles
- B - cut 8 - 3" x 3" squares in a color
- C - cut 2 - 8" x 3" rectangle in the same color as your squares

4 blocks

- A - cut 8 - 8" x 3" background rectangles
- B - cut 16 - 3" x 3" squares in a color
- C - cut 4 - 8" x 3" rectangle in the same color as your squares

Sewing Directions



1. Draw a line using a fabric pen on the wrong side of all the B squares from corner to corner.

- 2 Place a B square at one end of an A rectangle with the right sides together.
- 3 Sew on the line.
- 4 Trim the corner off 1/4" away from the seam line.
- 5 Press open.

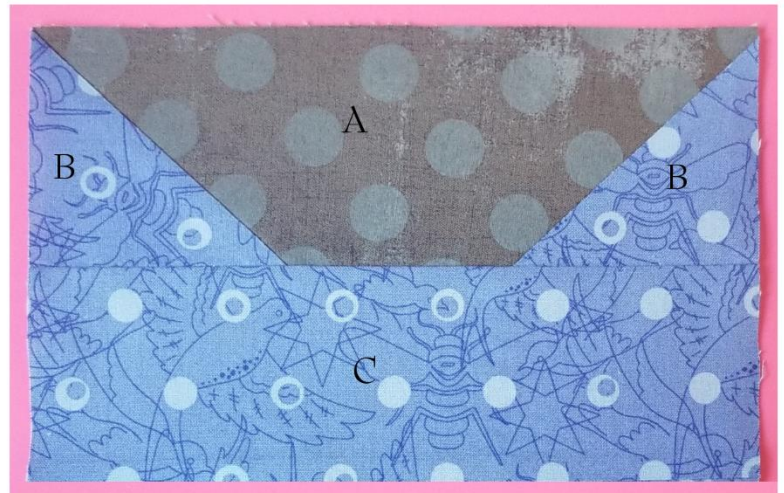


- 6 Sew another B square on the other end of the A rectangle with the right sides together. Making sure the seams are both toward the center on the top and pointing away on the bottom.
- 7 Trim and press the same as above.



- 8 Repeat one time if you are making 1 block. You will have two pieces like this for every block you are making.

- 9 Sew A/B to the long edge of C with the points going away from C
- 10 Press toward C
- 11 Repeat by sewing the other A/B piece to the other side of the C piece.
12. Press toward C
